Compare the letters 'i' and 'a' in the above signature and the Diaz. They are identical. The 'D' in Diaz and the 'R' in Rizal both show the same complex looping motion and both touch the previous word. Both signatures use a final flourish extending halfway back under the signature.

A handwritten signature in grey ink that reads "Jose Rizal". This signature is similar to the one above but is positioned mid-word, which affects the shape of the final flourish.

Here, the top part of the 'z' in Rizal is identical to the 'z' in Diaz, the differences are due to one letter being mid-word and the other being a final.
